Coach Thorvilson



David, a native of Helena, has just completed his eleventh season as head coach for the Saints Soccer Team. The Saints have won 7 of the last 11 Conference titles under Coach Thorvilson. David started his college career playing at Gonzaga University in Spokane, WA. After two seasons, he transferred to Montana State University

Billings to complete his education and collegiate career. He then became the assistant and goalkeeper coach for both the men's and women's teams at MSU-Billings. After two seasons, David ventured to North Dakota and became the graduate assistant for both programs at the University of Mary where he earned a Master of Business Administration. After graduation in the spring of 2003 the opportunity to return to Montana to be an assistant coach with Carroll College was too much to pass up. David spent four seasons as an assistant coach before taking the program over in the summer of 2007. Coach Thorvilson holds coaching licenses from both U.S. Soccer Federation and the National Soccer Coaches Association of America.

Training and Supervision

A certified trainer is on duty at all times. Roll call is taken twice daily. Dormitories are supervised by adult coaches and trainers. In addition, dormitory entrances are staffed 24 hours by campus representatives. Bed check is at 10pm nightly.
